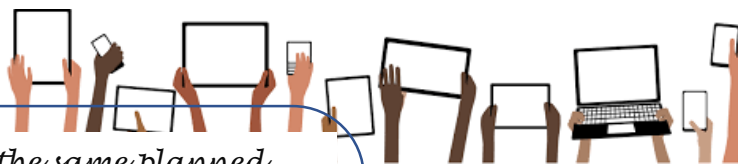


REMOTE LEARNING AT ST. MARY'S



We are teaching the same planned curriculum online as we would in school and has been emailed to parents. Certain subjects have been adapted where appropriate - for example, practical science, DT activities and team sports are some areas that will be focused on when all pupils are back in school.

Children will be taught by class teachers through prerecorded lessons each day. Videos of lessons are sent out via Google Classroom with activities to be completed on paper, work photographed and uploaded for the teacher. A range of other activities are encouraged, such as pupils making their own videos and podcasts. Lessons have been planned and set, in accordance with pupils' ability.



Pupil engagement is monitored by class teachers on a daily basis. Parents will be contacted, by phone, where there are issues with engagement. Solutions can then be discussed on an individual level. Problems with remote access will be dealt with as quickly as possible and as a last resort, paper packs will be provided.

Teachers view all work submitted each day and provide individual support to pupils via Google Classroom. Written feedback will be given at least three times per week for each pupil.

The Head Teacher and Teachers will be available throughout the home learning period to respond to parents' questions or concerns. Contact should be made via the school office.



We ask that parents plan a regular daily routine to incorporate the following:

<p>Early Years and Key Stage 1</p>	<p>3 x 1 hour lessons per day</p> <p>In addition to this for KS1, regular use of Bug Club Reading, Numbots/Times Tables Rockstars and Spelling Shed Apps</p>
<p>Lower Key Stage 2</p>	<p>2 x 1 hour lessons and 1 x 1½ hours lesson each day</p> <p>In addition to this, 30 minutes Doodle Maths or Literacy each day Plus regular use of Bug Club Reading/Reading Plus, Times Tables Rockstars and Spelling Shed Apps</p>
<p>Upper Key Stage 2</p>	<p>2 x 1 hour lessons and 1 x 1½ hours lesson each day</p> <p>In addition to this, 30 minutes set reading on Reading Plus or class text each day. Also regular use of Reading Plus, Times Tables Rockstars and Spelling Shed Apps (SATs Companion for Y6)</p>
